**Case Background**

Jennifer BOLEN voted two times in the November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 general election by completing a Wisconsin voter registration application on 11-03-2020 and writing her personal information on it to include the last four numbers of her social security number of [REDACTED]. Jennifer BOLEN also requested a mail in ballot from Arizona, by calling the Yuma County Recorder's Office, that was sent to her address in [REDACTED]. The Arizona ballot was requested on 10-22-2020, sent on 10-22-2020 and received back on 11-03-2020. The ballot number is 039G01, Ballot ID is B-40527526 from batch ID 4034.

All of the case numbers taken with this investigation are as follows: 2022-22045, 22046, 22048, 22050, 22051, 22053, 22055, 22056, 22057, 22058, 27859, 27860, 27861, 27862, 27863, 27864, 49812.

**Investigation**

On 05-11-2022, at approximately 1620 hours, I attempted to make contact with Jennifer BOLEN at her last listed and known address in Yuma, Arizona. The address is listed as [REDACTED]. I knocked on the door several times and although a canine could be heard inside barking, no one answered the door. Additionally the vehicle parked in the spot for [REDACTED] is registered to a much younger male subject that did not appear to have any affiliations with Mrs. BOLEN.

On 06-14-2022 I reviewed the documents provided by the Yuma County Recorder's Office and found that Mrs. BOLEN called and requested a mail in ballot to which one was

mailed to her in Wisconsin. It was returned and accepted on or about 11-03-2020. Mrs. BOLEN then allegedly voted in Wisconsin on or about the same time.

Currently the Arizona ballot envelopes, from the 2020 general elections, are locked in the vault at the Yuma County Treasurer's Office and a court order is required to access them for signature comparisons.

On 06-21-2022 a search warrant was drafted for the ballot envelope at the Yuma County Treasurers Office and signed by Judge Mark Wayne REEVES. On 06-22-2022 the search warrant was served and the ballot envelope was obtained. Copies of the signatures provided by the Yuma County Recorder's Office were sent with the ballot envelopes to the Arizona Department of Public Safety Crime Laboratory for analysis and comparison. I am currently awaiting the results. On 06-23-2022 the search warrant was returned to Judge Kathryn STOCKING-TATE.

### Narrative:

On 06-29-2022, at approximately 1140 hours, I contacted Mrs. Jennifer BOLEN via the phone number that was provided to me of [REDACTED]. The number has been disconnected with no further information.

I sent a request for information to the Wausau Police Department in Wausau, Wisconsin in an attempt to locate Jennifer BOLEN and obtain good contact information for her.

On 06-30-2022 I was advised by Sheriff's Dispatch that the Wausau Police Department had responded with information. I found that Jennifer BOLEN had moved to Kaukauna, Wisconsin with an address of [REDACTED]. The Kaukauna Police Department attempted contact at the address provided, however, she was not home at that time. A phone number of [REDACTED] was given to me.

On 07-05-2022, at approximately 0800 hours, I called the phone number provided two times and found that it was disconnected. At this point I have exhausted any means of locating Mrs. BOLEN for an interview.

At this time I will await the return of the signature analysis from the Arizona Department of Public Safety Crime Lab.

On 09-14-2022 I received word that Jennifer BOLEN had contacted Yuma County Voter Services trying to get information on her voting record for the 2020 general election.

Mrs. BOLEN advised the Yuma County Recorder's Office that she had an Arizona absentee ballot sent to her new address in Wisconsin, but was able to vote in person in Wisconsin. She was told by someone at the Yuma County Recorder's Office that her Arizona vote would be retracted. She advised that she had been contacted and told that she "double voted". Mrs. BOLEN left her current phone number with the Yuma County Recorder's Office.

On 09-18-2022 I called Jennifer BOLEN to see if she would speak to me. The following is a general summary of what we talked about.

I identified myself to her and asked her if she had a few moments to speak to me to which she stated that she did. I advised her that I was investigating voter issues in reference to the 2020 general elections. I asked her if she voted in the 2020 general election. The phone line then disconnected. I called her back and it was determined that the call was dropped but unknown from where.

Mrs. BOLEN stated that she got a call from the county that she lived in when she moved back to Wisconsin from Arizona saying that they had her vote that she did in person. She was also advised that her Arizona vote had also gone through. She stated that when she went on the website she could not find out anything. She also sent the Yuma County Recorder's Office and mail the week prior requesting confirmation because she had called them and told them (she had voted in Wisconsin) and they told her that they would remove her vote in Yuma. I confirmed that she spoke to someone in Yuma County about that.

Mrs. BOLEN told me that she is trying to track this down and she has been told that both of her votes were counted. I confirmed that she primarily lived in Yuma but moved to Wisconsin and was worried that she would not be able to vote. I confirmed that she requested an early ballot from Yuma and she stated that she thought Yuma had just forwarded one to her when she moved.

The Yuma County Recorder's Office would not know to do this or have her address unless she called them and told them. She stated that it was her understanding that they were

going to "erase that" and that her ballot would not go through (in Arizona) because she voted in person, in Wisconsin.

She explained to me that she had sent an e mail to voter services in Yuma and was waiting for a response. She stated that she looked at her old voter registration and it showed that she only voted in Wisconsin and there was nothing reported in Arizona.

I told her that her vote was counted here and in Wisconsin so it was a double vote. She stated that she does not know how to fix that. I explained to her that I was compiling the information that I could get and would be forwarding the information to the Yuma County Attorney's Office for review. She stated that she thought she got something in the mail indicating her Arizona vote had been retracted. She no longer has that information.

I told her that as far as I knew both votes counted because that is what I was told by employees at the recorder's Office. I explained to her that there would be no way for them to be able to track it until the voting had been completed and all of them were already counted. In order for them to know there was a double vote it would be long after everything was said and done.

Mrs. BOLEN stated that she had to get back to the investigator in Wisconsin as well. She was told that he was not looking to put charges on her and was just investigating it at that time. I told her that I was doing the same thing. She asked for my information to give the investigator up there. I gave her my information again to include the main office phone number. As of 09-25-2022 I have not yet heard from the investigator in Wisconsin.

She asked if people in these cases should get an attorney and I advised her that I did not want to give her bad information and I would not discourage her from speaking to an attorney. She stated that she would try to get in contact with the recorder's office as well. We then ended the conversation.

This case is being forwarded to the Yuma County Attorney's Office for review.
