**Case Background**

Daniel Dean SHROLL voted two times in the November 3<sup>rd</sup> general election by casting a vote in Oregon on 11-03-2020 and requesting an early ballot in Arizona on 10-11-2020 which was sent on 10-20-2020 and received back completed on 10-28-2020. The ballot number is 024G01, ballot ID is B-40483690 and it is from batch ID 5099.

All of the case numbers taken with this investigation are as follows: 2022-22045, 22046, 22048, 22050, 22051, 22053, 22055, 22056, 22057, 22058, 27859, 27860, 27861, 27862, 27863, 27864, 49812.

**Investigation**

On 06-14-2022 I reviewed documents provided to me by the Yuma County Recorder's Office. The documents consisted of voter registrations from both Oregon and Arizona with the alleged signatures of Daniel Dean SHROLL. I also reviewed a ballot envelope with the alleged signature of Daniel Dean SHROLL. The signature on the ballot envelope "Daniel Dean SHROLL" and the signatures on the registrations "Dean SHROLL" did not appear to match. A scientific analysis would need to be conducted for confirmation.

The only time the full name, "Daniel Dean SHROLL", is used is on the ballot envelope. The registrations were signed "Dean SHROLL". The double "L's" in SHROLL also appear to be different and closer together on the ballot envelope.

In reviewing the information I also found that Mr. SHROLL submitted a ballot on 11-03-2020 in Oregon and sent an early ballot in Arizona that was accepted on 10-20-2020, at the Yuma Foothills Library.

Currently the Arizona ballot envelopes, from the 2020 general elections, are locked in the vault at the Yuma County Treasurer's Office and a court order is required to access them for signature comparisons.

On 06-21-2022 a search warrant was drafted for the ballot envelope at the Yuma County Treasurers Office and signed by Judge Mark Wayne REEVES. On 06-22-2022 the search warrant was served and the ballot envelope was obtained. Copies of the signatures provided by the Yuma County Recorder's Office were sent with the ballot envelopes to the Arizona Department of Public Safety Crime Laboratory for analysis and comparison. I am currently awaiting the results. On 06-23-2022 the search warrant was returned to Judge Kathryn STOCKING-TATE.

**Narrative:**

On 06-27-2022, at approximately 1111 hours, I went to [REDACTED] in an attempt to contact Daniel Dean SHROLL. Mr. SHROLL was home and spoke to me. His wife was also present and was identified as [REDACTED].

The following is a general summary and is not verbatim.

I introduced myself and explained a little as to why I was there. I asked him if he voted in the 2020 general election and he asked, "here?", and I stated "anywhere". He told me that he did not vote anywhere but he did register and he had a problem with his registration. I was then told that they were not sent ballots. I asked them if they were on the permanent early voter registration. I was told that they are now and recently got the forms.

Mr. SHROLL stated that he went down to register to vote and they didn't let him just sign the papers. He was asked questions like if he was voting in another state. He stated that he felt like he was already a criminal. He said he felt like he wasn't being treated right but he did not think he called anyone or turned it in. He added that was all that happened to him. He stated that they leave Yuma and don't come back until November normally. I confirmed that they were in Yuma in November of 2020 and at first I was told no then they corrected and advised they get back to Yuma around October.

I then asked if they do, or do not, recall voting in November of 2020 and I was told "no, I did not vote at all". He stated that he tried to at the courthouse but they would not let him. He then talked about how he has an Arizona ID for fishing and asked if we were involved with what happened down the street. They then talked about how they are normally gone but are staying in Yuma to see a heart specialist.

I told him that I had a record of him voting in Yuma County in October of 2020. He asked "what precinct" and I told him it was at the Foothills Library. He denied voting at the library. I then told him that a ballot was submitted on November 3<sup>rd</sup> in Oregon. I then advised them of several addresses associated with them and was told they either owned it as rentals or had sold the property years prior.

I explained to him that we did have a record of him, or someone using his information, of voting two times in the November 2020 elections. I stated that he was here in Yuma in November of 2020, as he previously stated, and an in person ballot was submitted. Then there was a ballot cast in Oregon. He stated that he did not vote in either place. He stated that when he lived in just one spot he always voted there. He added that it is nice to know they are enforcing the voting regulations. Mr. SHROLL stated that I had more information on him than he did.

I asked him if he goes by Daniel or Dean and he said "Dean". I asked when he signs his name is it Daniel or Dean and he stated that he does that different ways. He then added that he uses Dean as it is easier except on "property stuff" he uses his full name in a recognizable way. He then added that "she" has learned to forge it a little bit, meaning [REDACTED].

I asked him if he would be willing to write down his name a couple of times so that I had something to compare it to and he stated that he would. He asked me what the name of my project was and I told him that it was called "Voter Fraud 2020". He stated that he has heard so many stories and he did not know whether they were true or not. He then talked about a town southwest of Las Vegas that had so many thousands of votes but not as many citizens living in town.

Kimberly SHROLL then started talking about the criminal element in her neighborhood and mentioned that everyone will now know the police were at their house even though we were in plain clothes and in an unmarked vehicle. Mr. SHROLL write his name using different variations with Daniel or Dean first and then with just his initials. Mrs. SHROLL continued to talk about the garbage on the lot across the street and people illegally dumping. They were given information on Planning and Zoning. After more conversation Mr. SHROLL completed his signatures.

Mr. SHROLL asked [REDACTED] if she wanted to sign his name too and she stated "no". [REDACTED] stated that they were very law abiding citizen's.

[REDACTED] mentioned that they were from the Portland area so I asked them about their mail and any problems with it. I was told that they always have problems with their mail. I was told by Mr. SHROLL that for years they were getting mail in ballots for his parent's that have been gone since the early 90's. I asked about specific problems with their mail in Portland and was told that it was because they have their mail constantly forwarded back and forth from there to here and sometimes they get it late or it's ripped. They also described someone going through their mail boxes across the street from their house here in Yuma. I asked if it ever arrived burnt and they stated "no". I then left.

The signatures that were provided to me were placed into evidence and will be forwarded to the Arizona Department of Public Safety Crime Laboratory for analysis and comparisons to what has already been submitted.

I am currently awaiting those results.

The report states:

1. Examination and comparison of questioned item #A1 with known items #1-1, #1-6 and #2 resulted in the following opinions,
2. The Daniel Dean SHROLL signatures on items #A1 and #1-1 were written by the same person.
3. Both similarities and differences are noted between the signatures on items #A1, #1-1 and the signatures on items #1-2, #1-6, #2. If additional course of business signatures of Daniel Dean SHROLL can be obtained, further examination would be warranted.

Mr. SHROLL is no longer in Yuma for the season and may return next year.

This case will be forwarded to the Yuma County Attorney's Office for review.

On 12-17-2022, at approximately 1330 hours, I met with Mr. [REDACTED] SHROLL to talk about their case.

I was advised that she had recalled after meeting with me the first time that she keeps meticulous notes and went over them in case I returned. [REDACTED] stated showed me her notes and a calendar where they had been sick most of November of 2020 with Covid and were in and out of the hospital. They do not even recall voting in the 2020 general election.

Mr. SHROLL also reminded me that there was a female walking up and down the street during that time frame opening mail boxes and taking items indicating that it was possible she took the ballots and voted them.

I explained to both that I was following up on some information and had received the results of the analysis the DPS lab had done on his signatures. I was told that it was not enough information and I would like them to complete handwriting exemplars. I then explained the process of completing an exemplar to them. Both stated that they felt his signatures were enough and that they did not want to complete the exemplars.

I do not have any further information on this case.
