## From Matt Braynard's Testimony to the Georgia House Government Affairs Committee December 10, 2020

From the State's database for the November 3, 2020 election and comparing that to the USPS Owned and Leased Facilities Reports, it is my opinion that 1,043 early and absentee ballots were cast by voters who were registered with a postal box disguised as a residential address.

...

This identified 15,700 matches of voters to records of those who had moved of the State prior to Election Day. Further, by comparing the other 49 states voter databases to the State's database, I identified 4,926 who registered to vote in a state other than the State subsequent to the date they registered to vote in the State. When merging these two lists and removing the duplicates, and accounting for moves that would not cause an individual to lose their residency and eligibility to vote under State law, these voters total 20,312.

Comparing these two lists by matching on full exact name and full exact date of birth revealed 395 individuals who both voted in the State of Georgia and in another state—a clear violation of state and federal law.
