**Disclaimer regarding illegal ballots versus illegal voters:** While this report identifies many illegally cast ballots and the names of ineligible voters in whose name those ballots were cast, it does not allege that those persons necessarily cast the illegal ballots. Determining who cast a ballot, legal or otherwise, particularly as a private, non-governmental organization, proves nearly an impossible feat.

**Disclaimer regarding redaction of voter information and research:** The public version of this report has redacted appendixes that include voter data and supplemental research. The full version, available to government and law enforcement officials and, on a limited basis, to select individuals and members of the media, has no such redactions.

## Summary

This brief is a follow up collection of county clerk responses in relation to the three sets that we published for Arizona, Georgia, and Wisconsin. These are either new responses or follow ups to prior emails. These prior clerk response collections are at:

In this report, we received responses from the Wisconsin Elections Commission (WEC) which confirmed our double voter find in Arizona and Wisconsin as was also acknowledged by the municipal clerks and Marathon County District Attorney in Wisconsin. We provide the receipts. As mentioned in our Arizona report, the Yuma County Sheriff announced an investigation into

this and 15 other cases (which Dinesh D’Souza and True the Vote tried taking credit for but were shown to be false): <https://www.yumacountysheriff.org/pr-2022/PR-2022-30-Yuma-County-Voting-Fraud.pdf> & <https://www.azmirror.com/2022/05/19/the-yuma-sheriff-isnt-investigating-election-fraud-because-of-2000-mules/>.

District Attorneys in North Carolina and Wisconsin are now aware of double voters and currently investigating these cases, which apparently clerks had not sent their way.

The Georgia Secretary of State’s Investigations Unit has kept us posted on the progress on the cases of P.O. Box voters and felons who registered in Georgia on parole from Florida. We hope to get responses and updates on these soon.

We request the assistance of citizens in these states and ask them to contact us so that they may file challenges and file complaints against potentially ineligible voters, and even clerks not doing their due diligence. This will empower citizens and force elected officials to be held accountable for their actions (or inactions).

Dear Ms. Bernarde and Ms. Goede,

I am writing to you to bring to your attention a voter named [REDACTED] who appears to have voted in the City of Wausau municipality (Marathon County) who appears to have voted in person in Wisconsin and also by mail in Arizona in the 2020 General Election.

It is possible someone used her information to cast a ballot in her name, but we have submitted her name to Yuma County, AZ elections clerk and they confirmed she was flagged by ERIC. Information on this voter is attached.

The Arizona voter portal confirms that subject has an inactive status voter registration due to an inactive address. Note that subject was a poll worker:

Social Media:

A LinkedIn account shows that subject is the owner of [REDACTED] LLC. It also shows subject had worked as a critical care nurse at Yuma Regional Medical Center from April of 2018 until September of 2020. Also note that from September of 2020 until June of 2021, subject worked as a trauma intensive care nurse for OneStaff Medical. Note that this position is a traveling nurse position:

A Facebook account for subject confirms the same business, [REDACTED] LLC, as LinkedIn shows:

Determination:

Subject's birthdate was indicated on smartbackgroundchecks.com and was confirmed through the Arizona voter portal. Property records indicate that subject is not the owner of the property in Arizona. A LinkedIn account for subject indicates that she was in Arizona until September of 2020, then worked as a traveling nurse from September of 2020 until June of 2021. Subject then started a business called Frontline Justice, LLC in Wisconsin in May of 2021. Voter portals from both City of Appleton and Marathon County Wisconsin confirm that subject has voted in the last two general elections in Wisconsin. Further research indicates that subject purchased property in Kaukauna, Wisconsin with a recorded date of May 25, 2021. Since subject had changed jobs in September of 2020 and started a business in Wisconsin in May of 2021 and also voted in the last two general elections in Wisconsin, subject is an illegal voter.

The person who voted early in Arizona voted between October 7-30.

If she voted at the polls in Wisconsin, then it could have been any time between October 20 - November 3.

It seems she resided at the Wisconsin change of address location [REDACTED] prior to the address purchased ([REDACTED]), but is still registered at [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] is the number that is associated with the nurse

In 2012 it placed the nurse in Appleton, which would match the 2016 vote. The 2020 vote placed her at a Wausau address, where she is registered.

It seems that she (or someone in her name) voted from an old address:

Other searches tie her to the previous [REDACTED] and the business is tied to her home address.

Additionally, [REDACTED] was featured in a 2016 article about her daughter who died due to having a disease, stating she was in Appleton.

Additionally, the photo of the home on Google maps taken October 2016 matches the one with her and her daughter taken in the September 2016 USA Today video (It also has a wheelchair ramp and the same hydrant):

Based on this, she seems to be the same woman with connections to both homes. She voted in the 2020 election in Wisconsin and Arizona, or had 2 ballots cast in her name, making her a likely double voter if not at least an illegal voter in Arizona.

Dear Mr. Ozanne,

I'm including evidence for what appears to be a double voter in the 2020 election that we found using the NCOA records, and found that this is the same person at both locations. I had submitted this voter to the Middleton County Clerk but heard no response. Additionally, she registered in Florida after registering in Wisconsin (which nullified her registration in Wisconsin), but (double) voted in Wisconsin anyway.

As such the subject was a double voter in the state of Wisconsin and Florida for the 2020 general election.

Thank you for your emails. As stated before, our office must follow Wisconsin statutes in maintaining the voter rolls, including when we remove a voter's name from the poll list or refer them for prosecution. While we appreciate your organization's efforts and attention to this issue, we cannot simply remove a voter from the rolls based simply on a spreadsheet and an email from a non-governmental source alleging that individuals are not eligible to vote. The State of Wisconsin regularly subjects the voter lists to several matching processes, including against the NCOA database, and provides municipalities with names of voters who appear to have moved. Even in those cases, we are required to provide a notice to the voter before changing their voting status because a change of address does not necessarily mean the individual is no longer eligible to vote in Wisconsin. In addition to the reasons you listed, an individual may move temporarily so that they are still eligible to vote from a previous address.
