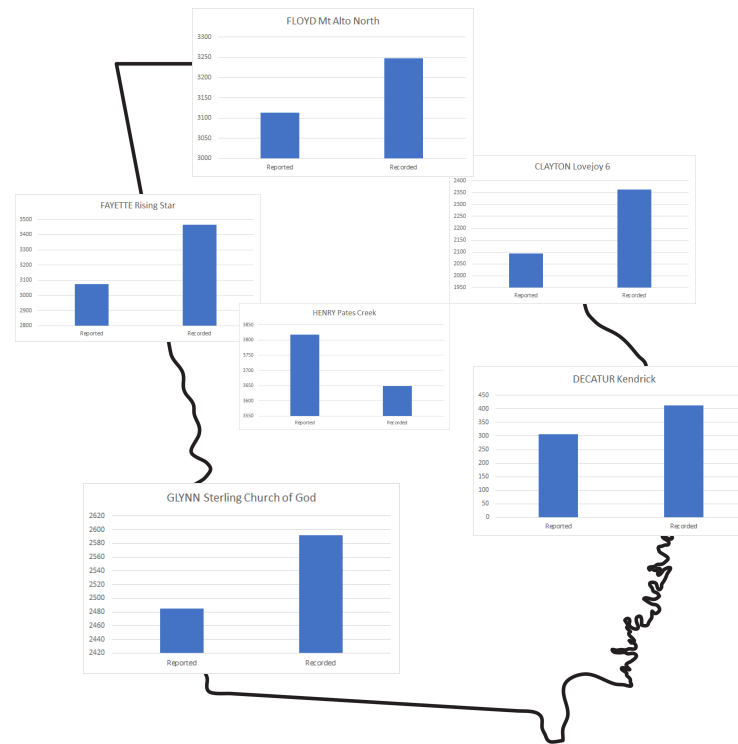

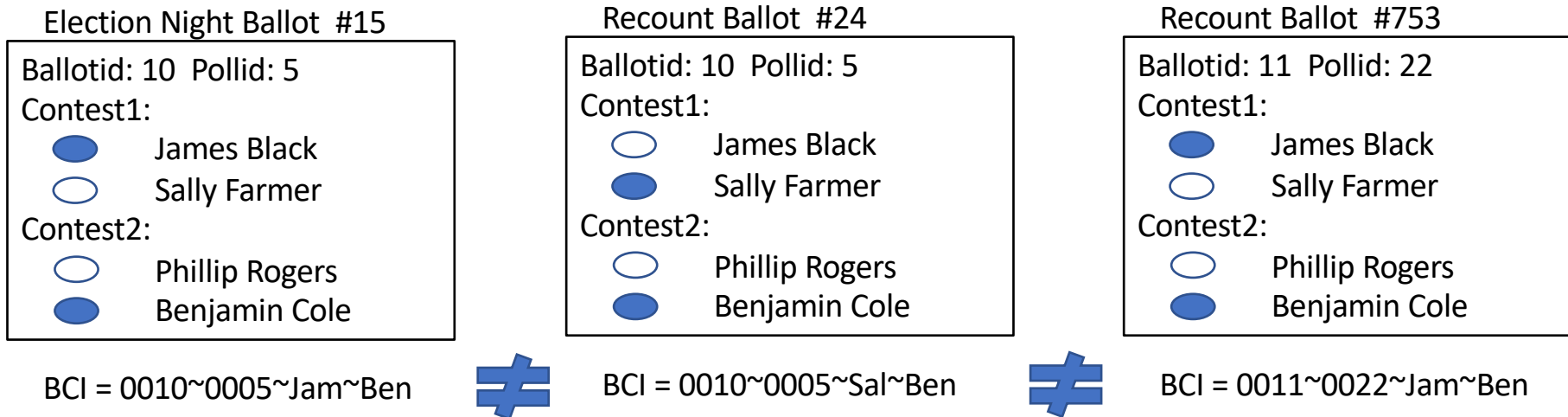

- MC1 – Machine Count 1 (Original Count Ballot, certified all down ballot races) (11/2-11/24)
- RLA - Risk Limiting Audit, hand count and partial audit (not official count)
- SoVC – Statement of Votes Cast from the County
- MC2 – Machine Count 2 (Recount)
- Stray – Ballots that are different between MC1 and MC2
- BMD – Computer printout of election choices from Election Day or In-Person Advanced voting. In Person Advanced is considered Absentee.
- Scanned – Ballots that go through the scanner to become ballot images
- Counted – Ballots that go through the scanner and are included in SoVC

Ballot Content Index

- It is Important to understand this concept to have a real understanding of a key component of the analysis.



The BCI is a textual representation of graphical ballot image data. Which allows for finding duplicates, changed ballots, added ballots, omitted ballots between or within ballot image populations furnished by the county.

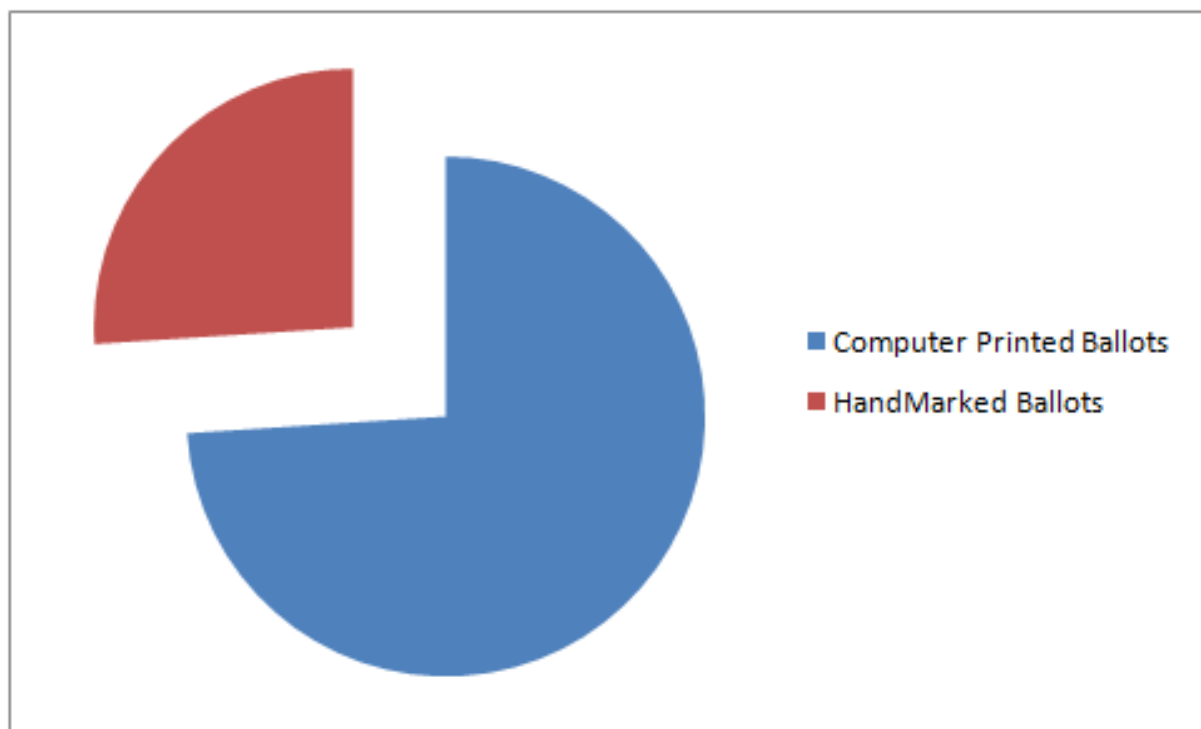
Findings Summary

- Ballots double scanned and counted in Original Count
- Ballot Images Added or Omitted between Original Count and Recount
- Ballots that have no corresponding record of having been cast by a voter
- Scanners Tabulate Votes Inconsistently
- 75% of ballot images are un-reviewable but can become transparent with a simple fix

Limited Scope of Citizen Review - 25% of Ballots

Computer Printed Ballots (BMDs) are **un-auditable** using ballot images.

Therefore, the scope of this review is predominantly limited to Hand-marked ballots which account for roughly 25% of the ballots cast in the 11/3/2020 election.

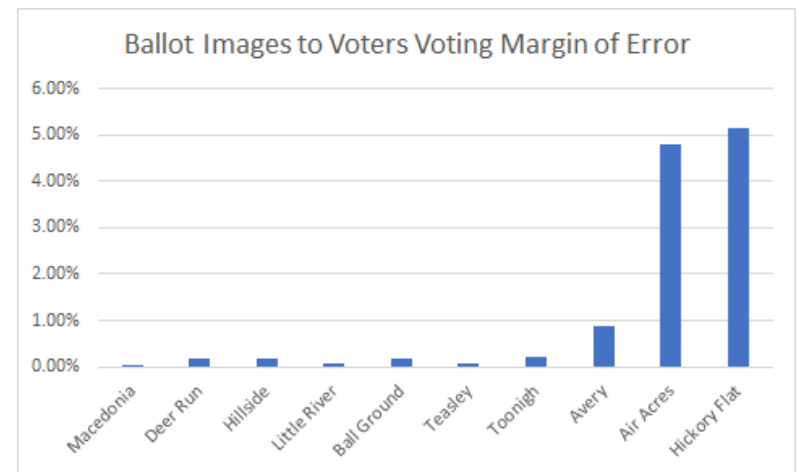

Main Precincts with More Ballots Counted than Voters Voting

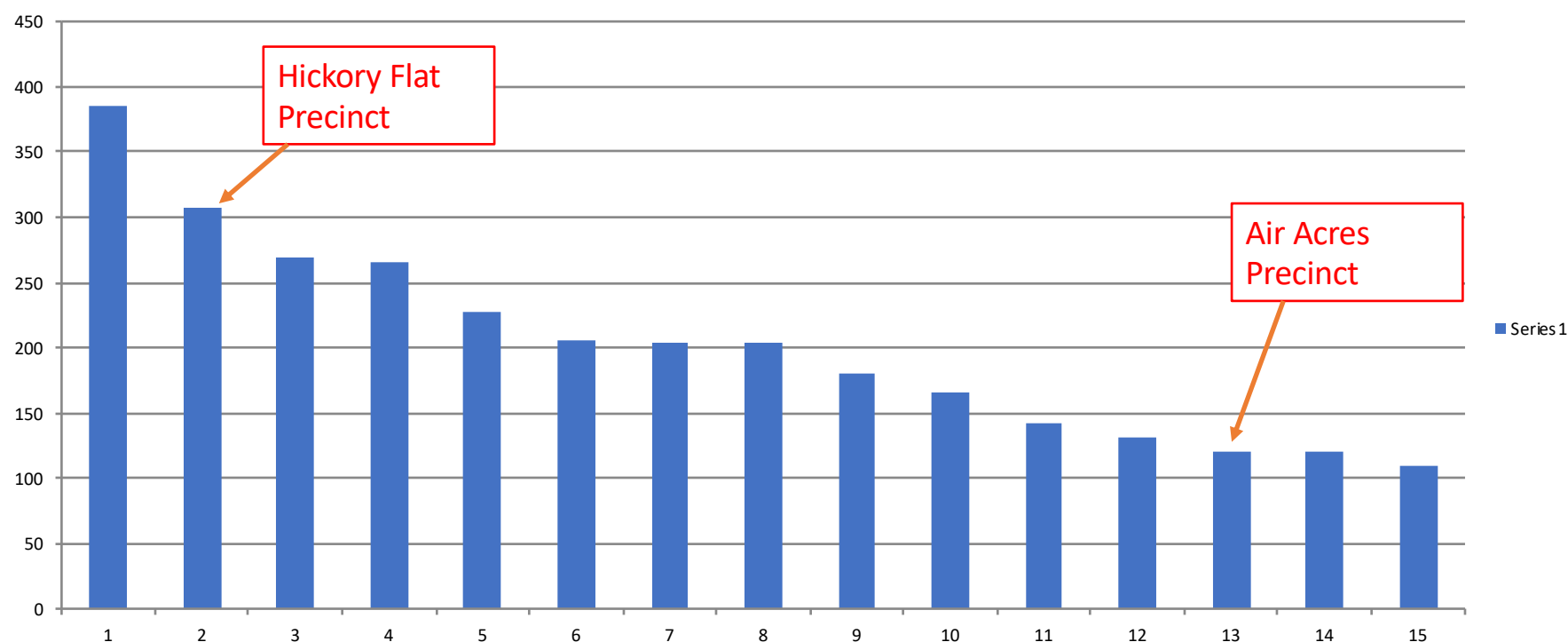
- Hickory Flat +317 (~5%)

- Total for county
 - 407 more Ballot Images than Voters but... some precincts have fewer ballot images than voters the county total is fewer than these 2 precincts

There are 435 more ballots counted than voters voting in 2 precincts

Locality of the discrepancy is important. It indicates a particular vs a systemic problem.

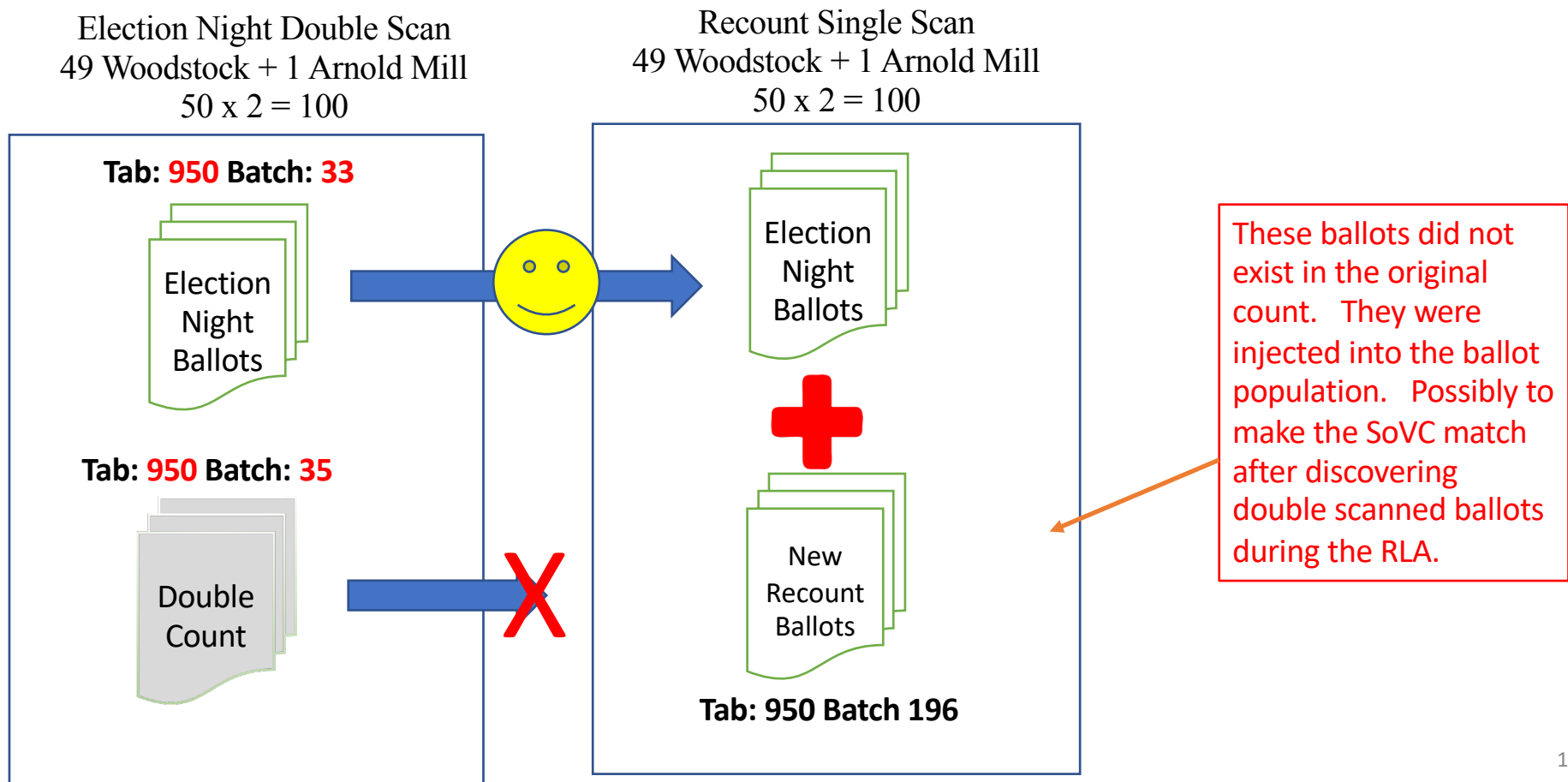

There were 274 ballot images either omitted or added between the original count ballot images and the recount ballot images provided by Cherokee County.

The 274 ballot image changes resulted in a net ballot image quantity change of -20 across the entire county.

147 Omitted Ballot Images – 125 Duplicate Ballot Images = 22 Omitted Ballot Images in Recount

127 Additional Ballot Images– 50 Explainable New Images in Air Acres = 77 Additional Ballot Images in Recount

Important Note about the recount

- If ballots were double scanned on election night, for example 2 scans of a ballot which selected Trump, Ossoff, and Loeffler, the election night vote totals reflect 2 votes each.
- If the ballots weren't double scanned during the recount, Trump would get one less vote. However, the extra vote for Ossoff, Loeffler, and any other downballot race remains in their vote totals.

SUMMARY OF CONCERNS

Major Areas of Concern

A. Discrepancies to Resolve

- 1) Double Counted Ballots
- 2) Apparent Physical or Electronic replacement of double counted ballots with new unique ballots between Original Count and the Recount
- 3) Physical or Electronic Injection of more Ballot Images than Voters Recorded as having voted
- 4) Computer Printed Ballots are not currently reviewable. Forged or Duplicate Computer printed ballots are undetectable with rare exceptions. 75% Blind Spot.
- 5) Multiple scans of the same ballot yield different results.

B. Double Counted Ballots were counted as part of the original count SoVC and the recount. Even if removed from the recount they were not removed for down-ballot races in the original count.

C. Ballot Images don't match the SoVC on Original Count

My Requests in Order of Urgency

- Cherokee BOER to require precinct reconciliation of ballots cast and counted to voters having voted
- Cherokee BOER to implement a post-voter numerical accounting mark on machine printed ballots (BMDs) in order to make them discernable from one another in a citizen based review.
- Cherokee BOER to request redacted Halderman security report on Dominion voting system for two purposes:
 1. BOER to implement local mitigations where possible
 2. BOER to request responses from SOS and St. Election Bd. for further mitigations if required.
- A formal investigation, preferably by the Cherokee County Board of Elections, but open to State Election Board if necessary:
 - Ballots Cast not reconciling to number of voters
 - Duplicate Ballots Counting in SoVC
 - Unexplained Ballot Deletions and Additions in the Recount
 - Inconsistent scanner tabulation for the same ballot

Cherokee County Election Board Response

Regarding the request for precinct level reconciliation of ballots cast: Poll managers from each polling location complete the following recap sheets: PollPads, Ballot Marking Devices, Ballot Recap, Provisional Ballots and Scanner/Ballot Boxes. These forms and election results (memory cards and tapes) are turned in on election night. Cherokee County Elections staff members will reconcile these recap sheets. After reconciliation, copies are retained by the Elections Office, and are provided to the Secretary of State. These are available at the public's request.



Cherokee County Election Board Response

Regarding Mr. Horton's request for a "post-voter numerical accounting mark" on ballots ("Bates-stamping"): While we appreciate your concern in this area, we have determined that it will not be feasible to implement this suggestion for the following reason:

- a. The requirements in the new election bill states that election workers keep working non-stop until the votes are counted. We are required to have the votes counted by 10:00 p.m. on election night. Thus, the imposition of any additional responsibilities on our workers that evening will jeopardize our ability to comply with this portion of the new law.
- b. By using this method of Bates-stamping, we would be departing from the election code and State Election Board rules, which do not provide for this.



Cherokee County Election Board Response

Regarding Mr. Horton's request for an investigation: As we stated above, we believe an investigation of your allegations will require an election security expert. Therefore, the Board's advice would be to send this report to the Secretary of State, as they have the resources and the experience.

Method of Identifying Double Scans:

- Unfortunately there is nothing Unique about BMDs so no way to visually determine whether they were duplicates or not.

HOWEVER

- There were **339** double scans discovered in a single precinct (Baker) by analyzing the contents of these votes across multiple batches

Double Scanned and Counted Ballots in SoVC

- It's impossible to determine whether these were the only duplicates across the county because not all duplicates are located in a serial fashion within batches
- It is important to note that even if duplicates are removed from the pool of ballots prior to the recount all of the down-ballot races remain affected by the duplicates

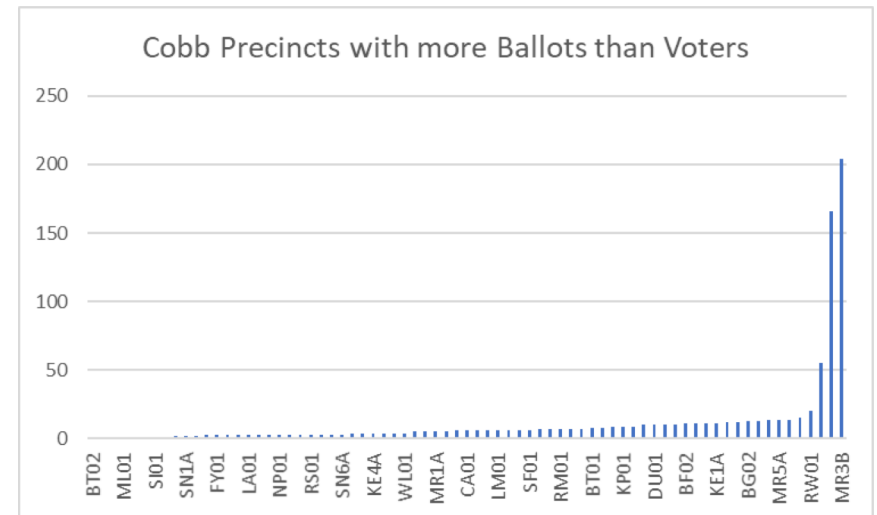

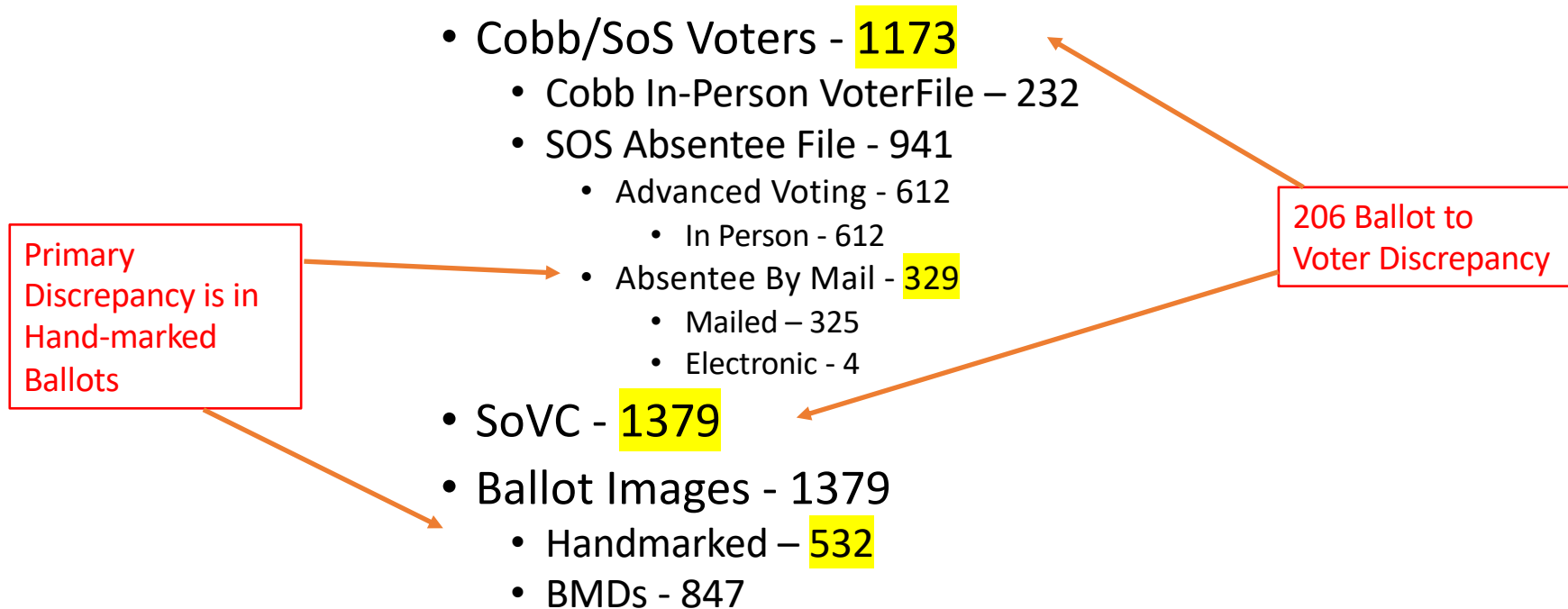

 - 862 more Ballot Images than Voters but... some precincts have fewer ballot images than voters so the net excess is 694

There are 427 more ballots counted than voters voting.

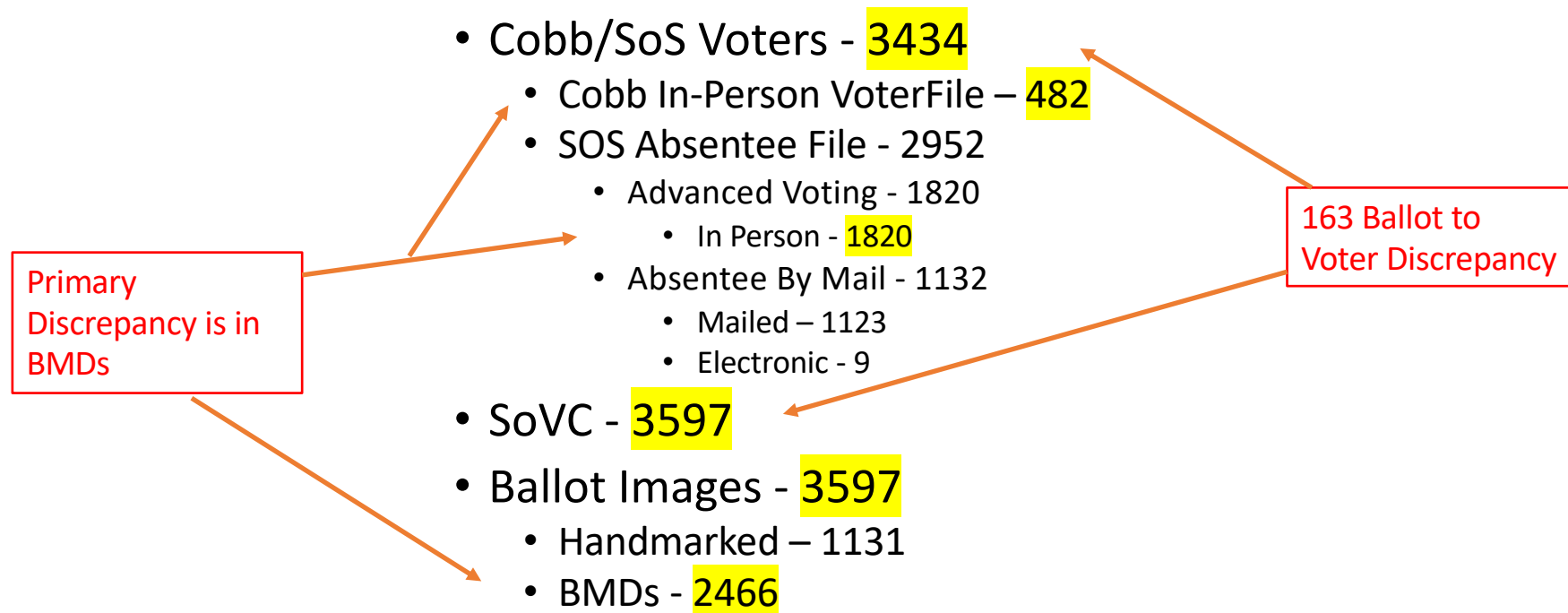
Locality of the discrepancy is important. It indicates a particular vs a systemic problem.
